Upper Allegheny Health System (UAHS) has announced that its member hospitals, Bradford Regional Medical Center (BRMC) and Olean General Hospital (OGH), will be restructuring in order to create a stronger, more viable regional system built around innovative centers of excellence.

This announcement provides both an opportunity and a necessity to reinvent a model of care for the 143,000 residents in the UAHS service area and ensure high quality care for the long term. Key aspects of the consolidation plan include:

- BRMC remaining a central part of UAHS and the community
- BRMC retaining 95 beds at the Pavilion, 28 beds for the Behavioral Health division, and 10 inpatient medical care beds
- UAHS expanding its regional network of 42 primary care and specialty providers, which includes 25 providers in Pennsylvania
- Current and future BRMC physician and mid-level offices in Bradford include primary care/family care services and specialists in orthopedics, cardiology, cancer, pediatrics, colorectal and general surgery, urology, ENT, and spine
- Women's Health Services will continue through Universal Primary Care; UAHS is also working to re-establish dental services in coordination with BRMC
- BRMC will offer imaging (MRI, CT, mammography, and ultrasound), lab services, sleep care, respiratory care, cardiac rehabilitation, Upbeat Wellness, Smart Rehab, Outpatient PT and OT, the infusion center and chemotherapy, occupational health, and wound care
- BRMC will sponsor the School of Radiography and Meals on Wheels programming
- OGH will continue to offer advanced services regionally, including: the ICU intensivist program, interventional cardiac catheterization, electrophysiology (EP), radiation oncology, vascular services, neurology, orthopedic surgery, OB/GYN, wound care including hyperbaric therapy, and dialysis
- With few exceptions, OGH participates in virtually all Pennsylvania health plans, including Highmark and UPMC plans
- Community health will be positively impacted by new health and wellness programs, as well as a community wellness center, and the addressing of chronic disease prevention
- Hospital community advisory boards will be initiated
- A reliable Bradford-Olean transportation option will be spearheaded by UAHS
